4. Describe the contents of the Zimmerman Note. What did Germany offer Mexico in return for attacking America?
5. Describe the reaction of the American people to the discovery of the contents of the Zimmerman Note.
6. Explain the events surrounding the Russian Revolution and the effect this had on WWI.
7. Read the short quote by Woodrow Wilson on page 676 and explain Wilson's key argument for U.S. involvement in WWI.
8. Describe the effect of the Selective Service Act on Americans. How did this law effect men and women of the United States?

1. Explain the role of the U. S. in supplying the Allies with goods and equipment during WWI.
2. What role did convoys play in the effort to supply Europe during WWI?
3. Who was Vladimir Lenin and how did the signing of the Treaty of Brest-Litovsk hasten the need for American troops to help contain Germany.
4. What was the effect of the arrival of the American Expeditionary Force and General Pershing on WWI in Europe?
5. Describe the events surrounding the end of WWI and the celebration of Armistice Day.

5. Describe the effort to ration goods at home in the U.S.. How did rationing help the U.S. war effort.

8. Describe the effect of the Espionage and Sabotage Acts on the American population during WWI.
